### **NSM, Udaipur: Introduction**

Situated at Dhajanagar, Udaipur sub-division of Gomati District of Tripura state, at a distance of 52 kms from State Capital Agartala beside the National Highway, Netaji Subhash Mahavidyalaya (NSM), Udaipur has been functioning as centre of higher learning in this remote rural setting for over four decades by now. The college started its journey as a tiny private entity with a few Arts Stream based subjects in the year 1964. It became Udaipur Government Degree College under the aegis of State Government on 21<sup>st</sup> September, 1979 (year of formal establishment) while renamed as Netaji Subhash Mahavidyalaya on 23<sup>rd</sup> January, 1997. Commerce and Science streams had been introduced in the year 1987 and 1997 respectively to offer all the General Degree Courses under single umbrella imparting education to the students of diverse socio-economic background, race and religion coming from entire Gomati District.

Spread around 4.62 acres of land area, the College campus house three relatively new multi-storey buildings, two old buildings and one single-storey building for imparting classes to more than 2,895 students primarily from nearby locations. The well-connected Central library of the College with reading room facility connected to Network Resource Centre (NRC) is located in the main building along with academic, establishment sections, well connected Professors Common Room, Seminar Hall among others. The main building also accommodates enclosures for Examination Cell, RUSA Cell, IQAC etc including a small chamber for Principal.



**Mission:** The mission of the NSM Udaipur is enshrined in college motto “साविद्यायाविमुक्तये” meaning “that is knowledge, which liberates”. The motto itself is indicative of the idea that knowledge has no boundary and liberates one’s soul through to self actualization. The mission is translated into ethos of inculcating human values, professionalism and scientific temperament to all sections of students irrespective of caste, color or creed.

**Vision of the College:** Vision statement focuses on imparting inclusive education to students by instilling human values, professionalism and scientific temper across all sections of students irrespective of caste, color or creed with due focus on female students.

**Mission of the College:** The mission statement includes:

- Provision for multifaceted development of local youths irrespective of caste, color or creed;
- Imparting quality education for students;
- Promoting inclusive education amongst educands;
- Equipping students with academic prowess to meet local/regional/national/global needs;
- Emphasizing on student-centric learning amongst learners with due focus on personality and skill development; and
- To make them aware about social developments and responsibilities entrusted upon them.

## **Student Enrollment and Strengths**

The NSM, Udaipur is one of the few Colleges in Tripura offering majority of courses meant for students pursuing general undergraduate education over the years. As of now, the College boasts of having 19 departments under single umbrella spread across three streams, namely, Arts, Commerce and Science. Arts stream encapsulates majority of departments which includes Bengali, Economics, Education, English, History, Geography, Kokborok, Philosophy, Physical Education, Political Science, Psychology and Sanskrit; of which Geography, Physical Education and Psychology offer practical oriented courses for aspiring students. Of the twelve Arts stream subjects, nine subjects simultaneously offer both Honors and General courses whereas rest three, namely, Geography, Kokborok and Physical Education offer only General courses. Science streams represented by subjects like Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Zoology, Botany, Human Physiology in Honors. Similarly for Commerce, both Honours and general courses are offered to students.

The College could accommodate 2,895 students across nineteen subjects in three disciplines during 2016-17.

## **Particulars of Teaching & Non-teaching Staffs**

The College is blessed with rich blend of faculties comprising of Associate Professors, Assistant Professors, Post Graduate Teachers (Higher Education) among others. As of 30.06.2017, a total of 51 faculties are serving in the College all across 19 disciplines- of which 7 are Associate Professors, 24 Assistant Professors and 20 Post Graduate Teachers (Higher Education). Apart from these, there are Guest Faculties serving in majority of the departments appointed annually (as per the directives of DHE, Tripura) for meeting inadequacy of teachers for teaching-learning activities of NSM, Udaipur.

Total 17 faculty members of the College are having Ph.D as a part of academic credentials on the date of reporting indicative of research exposure to relevant field of studies.

Non-teaching staffs of the College are backbone of facilitating teaching-learning and administrative activities of the institution since its inception. Apart from Principal, Drawing and Disbursement Officer (DDO) and Librarian, there are 33 Ministerial Staff, comprised of Upper Division Clerk (UDC), Lower Division Clerk (LDC), Laboratory Attendants', Library Sorters, Group D Employees and Sweepers among others, catering to both faculties and students over the years.

### **Departmental Activities**

The College seeks to carry forward both curricular and co-curricular activities for overall growth of students prior to their entry into realm of life. Curricular activities were designed by the affiliated Tripura University and practiced by the faculties for achieving the goal set out. In doing so, regular offline classes are held in between 9.30 am to 4.30 pm in normal working days across departments with the exception of holidays, examinations or any other official events.

Again, as a part of curriculum, sessional (internal) examinations are held as per routine prepared by the College Examination Committee during the first half of April and November every year. Classes resume immediately after the examination. Respective Departments of the College also organize Seminars/Group Discussion/Invited Lectures/laboratory-based activities/Swachh Bharat Abhiyan/Awareness Campaigns/Sports activities as deemed fit for students as a part of co-curricular activities for their overall development.

## Academic Result

Out of a total of 675 students appeared for 6<sup>th</sup> semester examination, 8 per cent of them scored more than 60 per cent or first division whereas 97.62 per cent could come out successful during the period.
