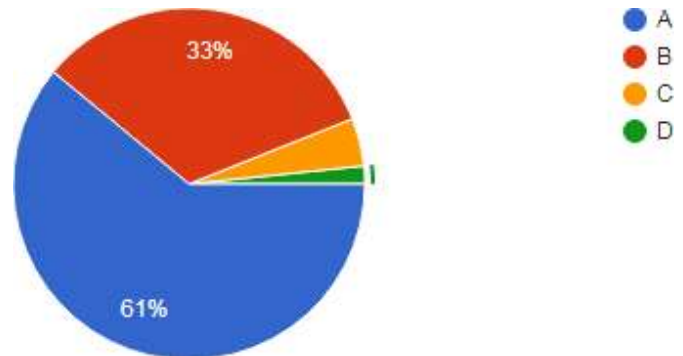

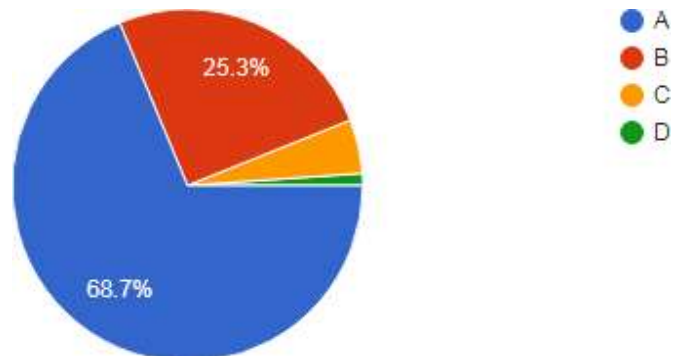
[Rating against Statements on A-D scale- A: Strongly agree; B: Agree; C: Disagree; D: Strongly disagree]

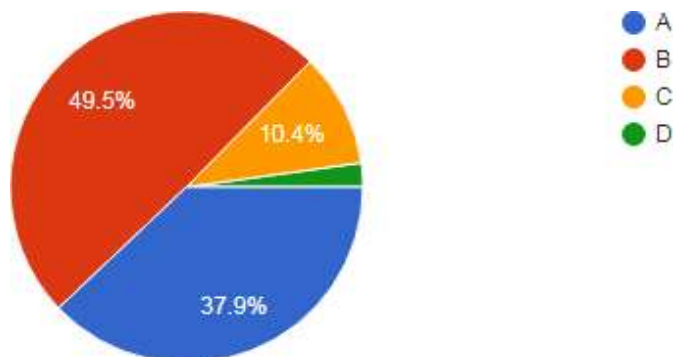

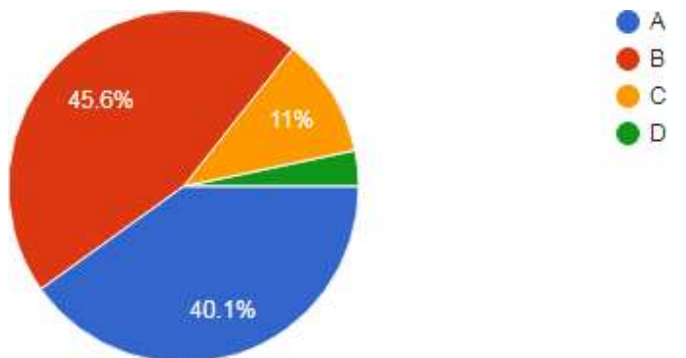

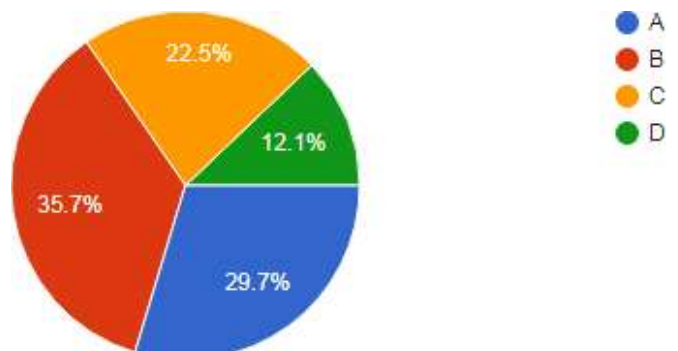

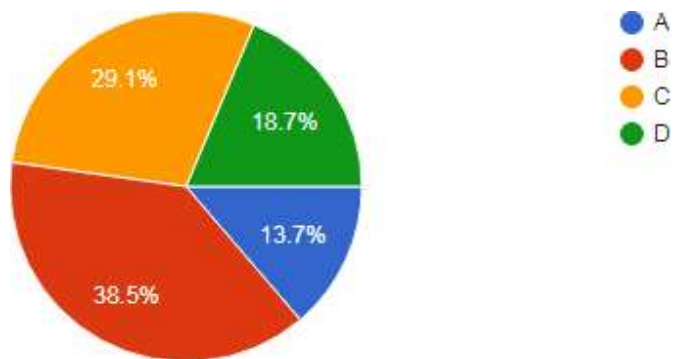

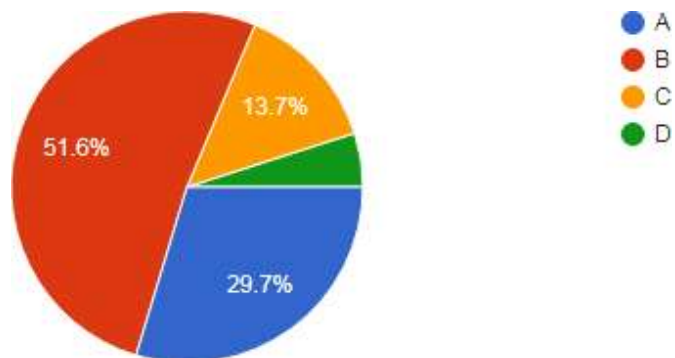

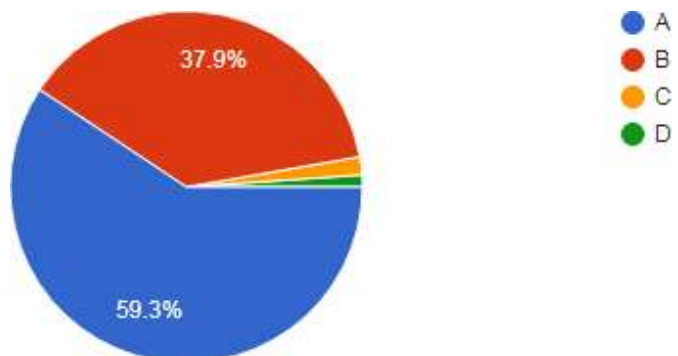

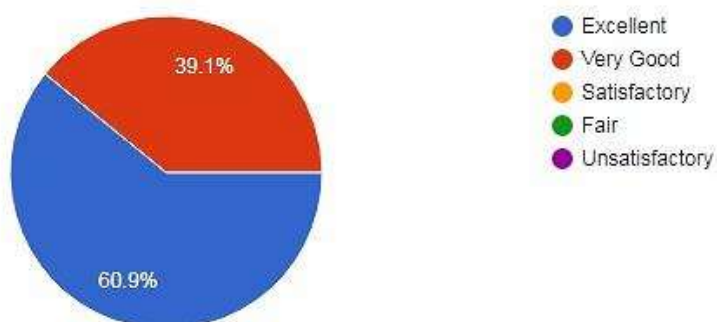

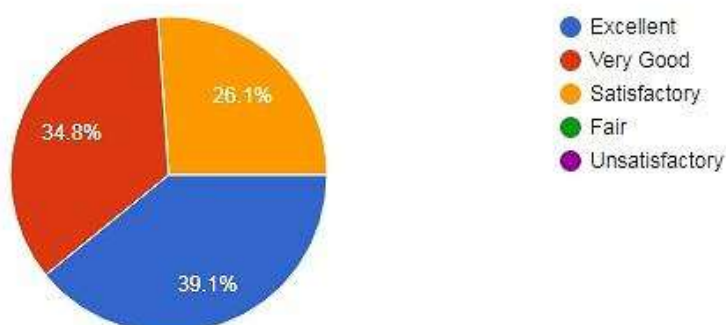
1. Your present job responsibilities as a college teacher

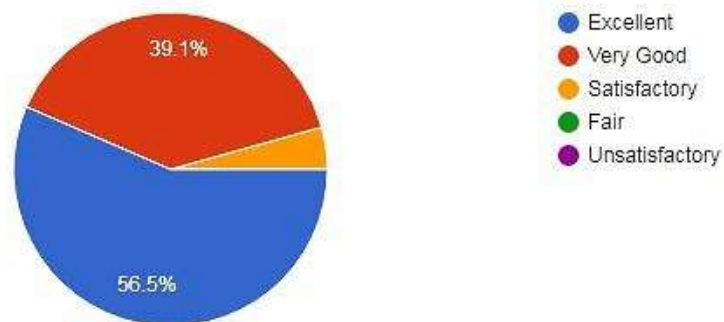
2. Culture in your college in terms of promotion of your flexibility as a teacher

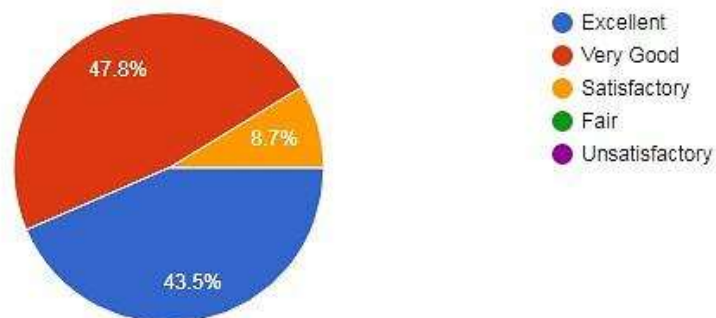
3. Your freedom over the instructional methods which you use to teach a particular subject

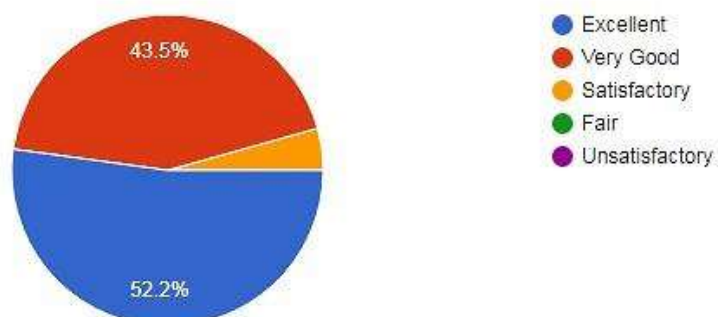
4. Your freedom in deciding the assessment methods/ parameters of your students

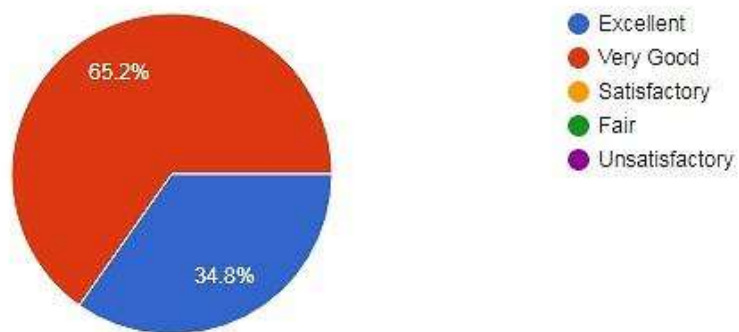
5. Leadership style of your departmental head

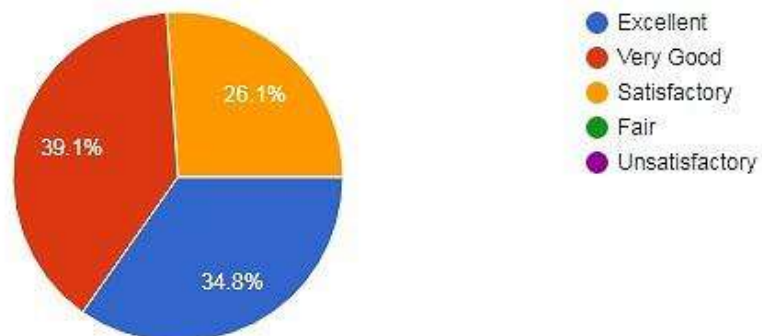

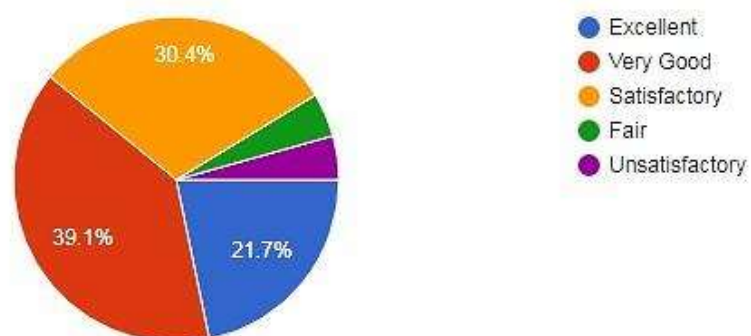

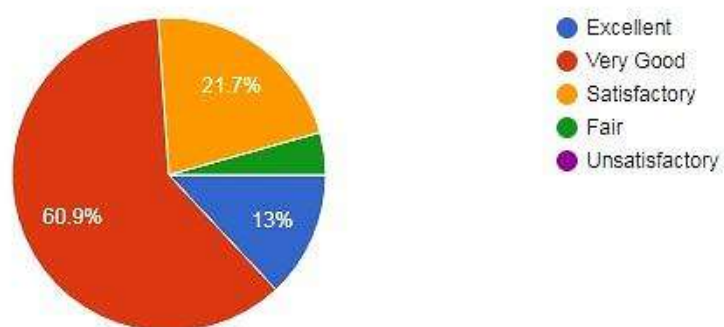

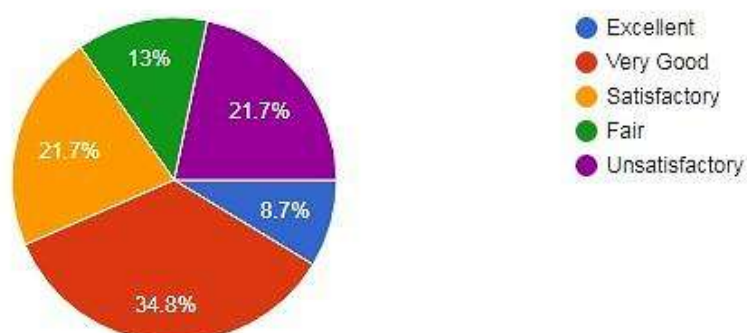

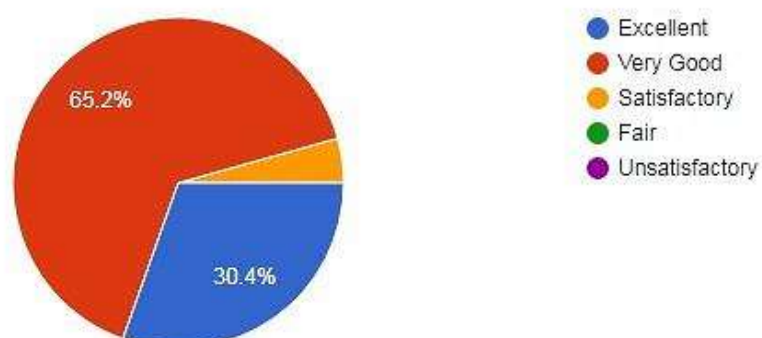

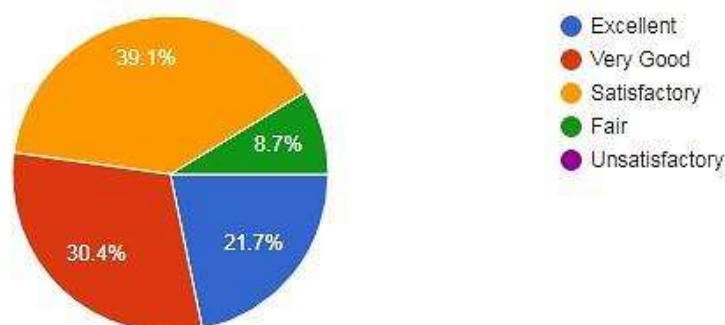

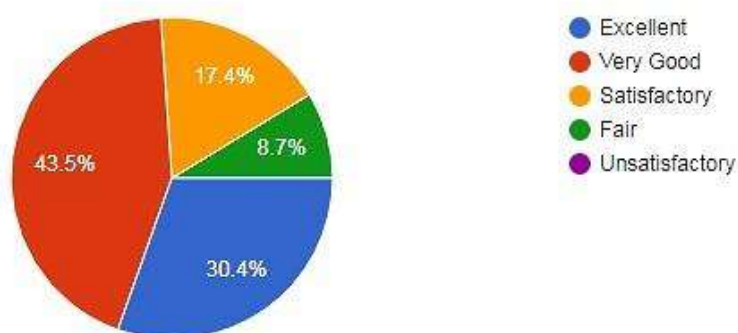
