Minister of Higher Education Mr. Ratan Lal Nath inaugurated the webinar. He hailed the efforts of the college and stressed on the need of such insightful webinar. Prof. M.K.Singh, Acting Vice-Chancellor of Tripura University took part in the inaugural session and put light on partition literature. Director of Higher Education, Saju Vaheed and Principal-in-charge of the college echoed the similar sentiment.

Renowned Professors and academicians from America, Poland, Pakistan, Bangladesh and India took part in this highly-watched webinar and discussed several issues related to partition literature. There was no registration fee for this webinar and more than five thousand viewers' participation made this webinar a huge success.
