To commemorate the 400th Death anniversary of Shakespeare, the Department of English, Netaji Shubhas Mahavidyalaya organized a panel discussion on 4th October 2016 at 11 AM in the Seminar Hall of the college. Professor Ashes Gupta, Dr. Partha Sarathi Gupta and Dr. Chaitali Garai, all from the department of English, Tripura University took part in the panel discussion. Sri Biswajit Gupta of Rabindranath Tagore Mahavidyalaya acted as the moderator for the same. Each of the panelists discussed on several issues concerning the life and works of the Bard of Avon. The areas of discussion included major tragedies, major comedies, sonnets, soliloquies and tragi-comedies like *Merchant of Venice*. The sole purpose of the event was to cultivate interest among the students about Shakespeare. This was followed by a quiz programme among the students of our college. Mrs. Patriot Debbarma and Mr. Faruk Ahamed, faculties of the department conducted the quiz session. The first round of the quiz programme was based on the book 'The Tales from Shakespeare' by Charles and Mary Lamb and the second round was based on the knowledge acquired from the panel discussion. Ten students each of class-XI from the neighbouring schools namely Brilliant Stars, Don Bosco, Assam Rifles HS School, Vivekananda Vidyapith, Ramesh Higher Secondary School, K. B. Institution and Udaipur Girls' H.S. School were invited and took active part in the panel discussion as well as in the quiz programme. The student participants of the programme were acknowledged with a participation certificate and the winners of the quiz were awarded with prizes. Altogether 160 students took part in the programme. Dr. Sanjoy Roy, the principal of the college applauded the initiative in his presidential address and Dr. Prasanta Chakraborty, Head of the department proposed the vote of thanks. The program was attended by the faculties and students of the college.
